Section 2 Include a portfolio (on CD) that includes at least 10 images. All materials should be labeled with artist's name, title of each piece (if any), media, dimensions, and year completed. Portfolio artwork may include drawings, painting, photography, ceramics, digital works, mixed media, printmaking, sculptures, et cetera. Portfolios may include coursework or artwork created outside of art courses, preferably within the past two years.

Section 3 Attach an Artist's Statement, which should include your reasons for wanting to be an artist, a description of artists and/or work that you admire, and your academic and artistic goals. Your statement should be concise, requiring no more than 250 words in length, and submitted with portfolio and application.

Section 4 Attach a 250-word detailed statement describing your financial need and explaining specifically how you intend to use the scholarship funds.

Section 5 Attach a letter of recommendation from current or past instructor familiar with your artistic qualifications.

Section 6 Attach a copy of transcripts for all prior college-level work and official proof of current registration at a Community College or University. High school seniors please provide high school transcripts and proof of plans to attend college in the fall.

Section 7 Attach a copy of current California Drivers license or other government-issued photo identification that also shows your current address.

Section 8 Read the statement below, sign and date this form, and return the complete application packet to the address listed on the first page this Application Form.
